- **Castle Dale Elementary**

- **Cleveland Elementary**

Cleveland has started the year focusing on Social Emotional Learning and Literacy. New Principal Jenny Gagon has started the year by celebrating student behavior. Her program encourages staff to find at least 3 students a day "caught being good". These students receive tickets to bring to the principal to celebrate that moment. On Friday, names are drawn for the "Principal's Club". The Principal's Club's activities vary from week to week. The first week the club got to eat pizza in the principal's office and the second week they will get to play games in the gym. We believe in taking a proactive positive approach to SEL and hope both efforts help students at Cleveland.

Cleveland is also focusing on growth in literacy this year. Our staff has challenged every child to read 40 books on their independent reading level throughout the school year. We will identify every child's reading level, update classroom libraries with leveled books, level and label all books in our library so students can easily access materials on their level, and finally give students time to read so they make growth. As students reach milestones, we will celebrate and acknowledge the number of books they read. To track and monitor growth, we will test students on their level at least three times a year. Our new program will also include structured phonics intervention time for every student in K-2. We are working with Principal Hughes from Cottonwood Elementary who has used a similar phonics intervention program with great success.
