

Emery High Reopening Plan



Please know that we are working very closely with our local health department in following recommendations and guidelines.

- *Every student will be issued a spartan mask on registration day. It will be free of charge. If additional masks are desired students may purchase them at the office. We will also have disposable ones on hand at no cost.*
- *Students may choose to bring their own mask from home. All masks must be appropriate for a school setting.*
- *If a student refuses to wear a mask, the student will be sent home. (Masks are a state mandate)*

Classrooms:

- Teachers will utilize seating charts to facilitate contact tracing.
- Teachers along with custodians will facilitate regular surface cleaning. (At each class break)
- Teachers will facilitate distancing in classrooms as much as space allows.
- Teachers and students will wear masks/face shields in the classroom where social distancing is not an option.
- Technology devices will have surfaces cleaned after each use.
- Teachers will remind and encourage students to wash hands regularly.

Transitions:

- Traffic flow and signage will be placed on the floor for students to transition between classes.
- Classroom doors will be open as often as possible to minimize high touch areas.
- Students will be encouraged to maintain social distancing in hallways and during transitions.
- Masks/face shields will be required for transition periods.
- Congregating during transitions will be minimal.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at designated entry and exit points in the school.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom.

Entry/Exit points:

- School visitors will be required to wear a mask and have a temperature check.
- Entry and exit doors will be sanitized often throughout the day.
- Floor markings and signs will be placed at entry and exits to help with the flow of students.
- Staff will work to discourage congregating and clustering of students.
- It is recommended that students socialize outside the building as weather permits.

Restrooms:

- Prominent signage will be placed in all restrooms promoting hand washing and sanitizing.
- Custodial staff will clean and sanitize restrooms regularly during the school day.
- High touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly.

Transportation:

- Students will be assigned seats on the bus to and from school.
- Students will be required to wear a mask on the bus.
- Students will be required to wear a mask for extra curricular activities travel.
- Buses will be sanitized at the end of each day and or trip.

Cafeterias:

- Traffic flow arrows will be placed to help the flow of food lines. Entry as well as exit arrows.
- Students will be encouraged to social distance and be required to wear masks while standing in line. After eating, students will be required to put masks back on upon exiting the cafeteria.
- Students will be encouraged to eat outside or other spacious areas as much as possible. Tables and benches will be available outside and throughout the school. We strongly encourage and require students to clean up after themselves.
- The cafeteria will be marked with signage as to where students may sit.
- Hand sanitizer will be available upon entry and exit of the cafeteria.

Large Group Gatherings:

- For the time being, school wide assemblies are strongly discouraged.
- Necessary assemblies will be held multiple times and with smaller groups.
- Current state guidelines will be followed for face coverings.
- Hand sanitizers will be available upon entry and exit in this setting.

Unique Courses: (Chorus,Band,Weights,FACS,Auto,Welding,Woods,etc.)

- Custodians will pay closer attention to these settings.
- Teachers will be creative in social distance guidelines.
- PE classes will not be required to wear masks when engaged in physical activity. They will still be required to try and social distance.
- Alternative classroom settings will be at the discretion of the teacher and administrator.

Special Education/Related Services:

- Seating charts will be used in classrooms.
- The district will provide face shields for special education teachers, speech and language, counseling, social workers.
- Reasonable accommodations will be provided for students that are unable to wear face coverings.

Testing Center for Online Students:

- Online students will be required to take tests at EHS during the school day. Each teacher will provide instruction in their syllabus for their students and individual classes.
- Homework class is still available Tue, Wed, and Thurs. 3:00-6:00 in the library. Testing may also be done at this time.

UHSAA/Extra Curricular Activities:

- We will follow the color phase (Orange, Yellow, Green) spreadsheet established by the sports medicine advisory council and UHSAA. For all indoor and outdoor activities.
- We will work very closely with our local health department on our current COVID situation and follow any recommendations and guidelines.
- Hand sanitizers will be available during contests for those participating.
- Signage will be displayed at each venue to remind spectators to follow certain guidelines.
- Spectators are encouraged to maintain physical distancing and sit in family groups if possible.
- Home team will do a temperature check before the student athlete enters the locker room.
- Visiting team will do a temperature check before the student athlete loads the bus.
- All participants must have their own hydration containers.
- Before traveling to other schools, we will check to see what color their county is and what requirements we need to follow.
